

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE

DISCUSS TRANSITION BETWEEN CITY AND TOURISM

Mayor Rudder and the City Councilmembers discussed the transition of employees from the City to Tourism. There was discussion regarding the transfer of health insurance and retirement benefits which will not take effect until January 1, 2022. The transfer between the City of London and London Tourism and Convention Commission will take effect on November 1, 2021. The Tourism Commission is working on their handbook, job descriptions, and payroll services.

DISCUSS APPOINTMENT TIMELINE FOR TOURISM COMMISSIONERS

Mayor Rudder and the Councilmembers discussed the appointments to the Tourism Board. The Councilmembers discussed the date discrepancies with Tourism members. Mayor Rudder went through the history of the Tourism appointments and the association nominations. The Mayor and Council discussed new appointees being placed on the Board in the middle of their predecessor's term and the process for that. Attorney Bryson stated the Council is not involved in the appointment process, only the Mayor and the three different associations. The Mayor stated he would meet with the President of the Hotel and Motel Association to discuss the issue.
