EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2025-03 OFFICE OF THE MAYOR CITY OF LONDON, KENTUCKY

SUBJECT: Open Records Request Procedures

WHEREAS, the City of London is committed to ensuring transparency and compliance with the Kentucky Open Records Act; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish a clear and consistent process for residents of Laurel County and Kentucky to request and obtain public records while maintaining the integrity and security of city documents;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Randall Weddle, Mayor of the City of London, by the authority vested in me, do hereby order the following procedures for open records requests:

1. Submission of Requests

- Open records requests from residents of Laurel County or the Commonwealth of Kentucky may be submitted in person, electronically, or by mail to the Office of the City Clerk.
- Requests submitted in person shall be made at City Hall, Office of the City Clerk, 501
 South Main Street, London, KY 40741.
- o All requests must be submitted using the **Attorney General's standardized Open Records Request Form**, which is readily available for public use. See KRS 61.876 (4)
- Requests shall be made during regular business hours: Monday through Friday, 8:00 AM
 4:00 PM.

2. Review of Records

- All Laurel County residents shall appear in person to review records before any copies are made.
- No copies will be provided until an in-person inspection of the records has been completed.

3. Copying and Mailing of Records

- After in-person review, if copies are requested, the requestor must provide a valid mailing address.
- o Copies will only be mailed following the in-person inspection.
- o A fee of \$0.10 per page shall be charged for copies, in addition to the cost of postage.
- o Fees are payable at the time of request submission.
- Individuals exempt under KRS 61.878 shall not be subject to these fees.

4. Point of Contact

o All requests shall be directed to the Office of the City Clerk at the address stated above.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its issuance and remain in full force unless modified or rescinded by further order.
